2023 CAUCUS

The purpose of the Town Caucus is to nominate candidates to be placed on the Spring Election ballot, which will be held on Tuesday, April 4, 2023. Qualified electors of the municipality may nominate and vote for candidates. Any person who is a United States citizen, 18 years of age or older, who has resided within the municipality for at least 28 days before the caucus is a qualified elector.

PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATION

Nominations are made separately for each office. Nominations are taken from the floor; each nomination must receive a second. After each nomination is made and seconded, the caucus chairperson will ask, "Are there any more nominations?" and hearing none, will ask three more times for nominations, and then announce that "Nominations are closed."

If more than two persons have been nominated, a vote will be conducted to reduce the number of candidates to two. The electors select two tellers to canvass the vote. The caucus chairperson will announce the names of all candidates. Each elector is entitled to vote for one candidate. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes are nominated and certified to the Clerk by the caucus chairperson and tellers.

The assignment of name placement on the ballot will occur after the nominated candidates have been certified by the Clerk. (If needed)
